This workshop will be split into in-studio sessions at Rick Paulus's studio in Wareham, MA, and beach sessions on Scusset Beach, at the Eastern end of the Cape Cod Canal, in Sandwich, MA. After extensive research, it has been determined that Scusset Beach offers the best quality sand conditions for our work in this part of Massachusetts. Masscribes has made an arrangement with Posseidon to ensure the tides on those days will be perfectly aligned for our afternoon beach art sessions—with the potential for a special sunrise session for the more ambitious of us, early on Sunday morning.

Both locations are approximately one hour from downtown Boston and the same distance from Providence.

If you are coming from afar, there is abundant lodging available in Wareham and surrounding towns.

For those who enjoy sleeping on the ground, Rick has offered his expansive meadow and surrounding forests for you to park your camper or pitch your tent. There are two nearby neighborhood beach communities, Onset and Parkwood Beach, that have several Air B & B houses available for those who are interested in pooling resources and enjoying a fall weekend at a beach house.
